#### **Instructions**

Thank you for your interest in participating in the American College of Physicians' (ACP) annual scientific meeting. The Internal Medicine Scientific Program Committee (IMSPC) is now accepting proposals for Internal Medicine Meeting 2026, which will be held in San Francisco, CA on April 16-18, 2026. The IMSPC welcomes all proposals\*, though faculty who have previously presented at ACP scientific meetings or chapter meetings are given the highest priority. If you have not participated in a chapter meeting, we encourage you to contact the governor of your local ACP chapter and explore the possibility of participating in an upcoming meeting.

In order for your proposal to be forwarded to the Internal Medicine Scientific Program Committee for consideration please:

- 1) Complete the Proposal for Internal Medicine Meeting 2026 application.
- 2) Include documentation of the practice gap the session will address. Documentation may be a peer reviewed journal article, national QI data, etc. A description of the gap without supporting evidence will not be accepted.
- 3) Attach curricula vitae for all faculty who will participate in the proposed session.
- 4) Complete the Temporary Disclosure of Relationships Form.
- 5) <u>Proposals must be received by May 15, 2024.</u> Proposals received after the deadline will be considered for the 2027 meeting. Submit completed proposal to:
